I AM the Light of the World

Text: John 8:12; 9:1-7

¹² Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

¹ As he passed by, he saw a man blind from birth. ² And his disciples asked him, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?" ³ Jesus answered, "It was not that this man sinned, or his parents, but that the works of God might be displayed in him. ⁴ We must work the works of him who sent me while it is day; night is coming, when no one can work. ⁵ As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world." ⁶ Having said these things, he spit on the ground and made mud with the saliva. Then he anointed the man's eyes with the mud ⁷ and said to him, "Go, wash in the pool of Siloam" (which means Sent). So he went and washed and came back seeing.

Discussion Questions:

2. How has Jesus been the light to you in times of darkness?
3. Do you ever struggle with the worry that your personal suffering is always a result of your personal sin? How does that type of thinking affect you?
4. How does Jesus's interaction with the blind man in John 9:1-7 demonstrate how we can respond to those in difficult situations?
5. When we encounter dark times, how do we let Jesus be the Light of our World?
6. How can our group pray for you?
