

DISCIPLES OF JESUS



Theme: Experiencing God

Word: Matthew 4:18-22

18 As Jesus was walking beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon called Peter and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. 19 “Come, follow me,” Jesus said, “and I will send you out to fish for people.” 20 At once they left their nets and followed him. 21 Going on from there, he saw two other brothers, James son of Zebedee and his brother John. They were in a boat with their father Zebedee, preparing their nets. Jesus called them, 22 and immediately they left the boat and their father and followed him.

Discussion:

1. Reflection: Before becoming a disciple of Jesus what were your “nets, boat and father” that you were holding on to.
2. Read: James 1:2-8. As disciples of Jesus we are sure to suffer. Share of your most recent suffering that you went through (or currently going through) and how have you persevered (or how are you persevering through that)? What happens when we doubt?
3. What is our reason for being disciples of Jesus? Are you fishing for people for the kingdom of God?

Prayer Points:

1. Pray for those suffering in our church physically and/or spiritually.
2. Pray for this pandemic and how it is affecting the whole world – for strength, protection and wisdom as we face it together.
