Discussion Questions:

- 1. In desperate times, what things to you factor in your decision making?
- 2. Do you ever feel like God's hand is against you? When you feel like that, how should you respond?
- 3. What can we learn from her statement about what love is? Loyalty? To whom should we have similar levels of loyalty and commitment?
- 4. Examine your own attitudes and emotions. If you have become bitter or resentful toward a person or toward God, then before you can be filled spiritually you must deal with that bitterness.
